Minor in Asian American Studies

A minor in Asian American Studies requires a minimum of 18 semester hours. Twelve of the 18 hours must be in residence. Nine hours must be advanced. **Minimum 2.00 Grade Point Average** for all courses applied to the minor is required. All students are required to take the following courses in this Minor.
