\*\*\* SPCH 1321 does not have an equivalent course at UH, but will transfer and is the **preferred** course to meet the Business Filed of Study Speech requirement (COMM 1FOS). SPCH 1311 is allowed with appropriate content only: 50% or more on preparation and presentation of professional speeches (requires petition and syllabus). SPCH 1321 or 1315 (or 1311 with approved petition) will waive with substitution COMM 3356 or MARK 3337, a required course for the BBA.
