- > Admission into the UH Teacher Education Program in Pre-Teaching Requirements:
 - > 2.50 GPA in overall education coursework and specialization area coursework
 - > Minimum THEA score in each of the following areas: Reading: 250, Math: 230, Writing: 240

A maximum of 66 hours (grades C- or better) of 1000/2000 level transfer hours may be applied toward a UH degree.

TEXAS UNDERGRADUATE IN-STATE TUITION ENROLLMENT CAP

Students enrolling at a Texas public university or community college for the first time will be affected by the enrollment cap. There is now a limit on the number of hours those students may *attempt* while paying in-state tuition.
