*The purpose of this information sheet is to provide students with specific information about course prerequisites for occupational therapy programs. Students following an occupational therapy track may choose any major, but the degree plan must contain the prerequisite courses required by the school the student plans to attend. **This sheet should be used along with the articulation sheet for the chosen major.***

*The University of Houston does **NOT** have an occupational therapy program. The courses listed represent some of the courses required by most occupational therapy schools in the area. This list is meant to be a guide. It is the student's responsibility to contact the individual occupational therapy program to find out the specific prerequisites for admission into that program. For additional information contact the Allied Health advisors in Academic Advising (see number at bottom of page).*

Please choose 66 hours from the list above. Only 66 hours (grades C- or better) will transfer towards your degree.

- * This is not required for all pre-occupational therapy programs. Contact each program for further information.
- Most programs require a minimum GPA of 2.50 on pre-professional courses with a higher GPA often required for the science courses.
- Applicants to the professional programs are expected to have some knowledge of the profession which can be gained through volunteer and/or work experience, observation in a clinical setting, personal contact with an occupational therapist, etc.
- Students who currently attend UH should refer to their departmental advisor **BEFORE** taking courses at another college.
- Courses listed above are **suggested** courses for this degree. Other courses in combination may apply to a degree.
