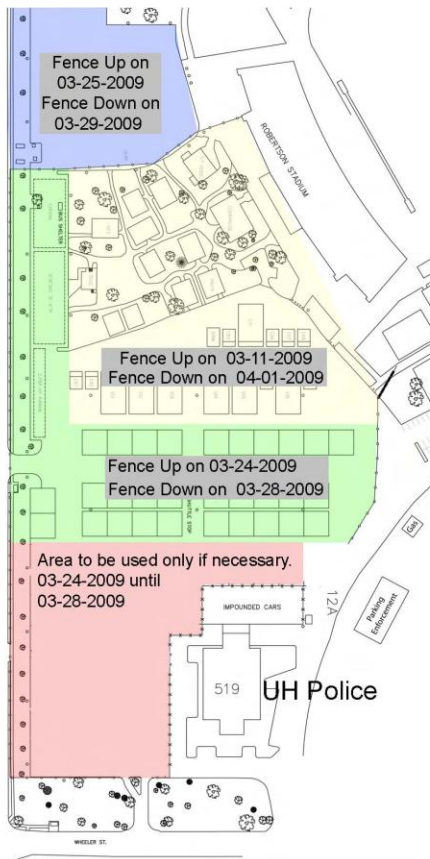

FRONTIER FIESTA PARKING CLOSURES

Houston, March 12, 2009 – From March 26 through 28, the University of Houston will be celebrating its oldest tradition, Frontier Fiesta. Frontier Fiesta is a student-led festival hosted by the University of Houston to promote scholarship, community, and education of the UH community. This year a portion of the lots by Robertson Stadium will be transformed into a fully functional town called "Fiesta City." Frontier Fiesta features free live concerts each night, variety shows by student organizations, carnival booths, multicultural performances, and a BBQ Cook-off.

To accommodate Fiesta City, some parking spaces in lots 12A and 12B will be taken off line.



Schedule of Frontier Fiesta Parking Closures

- The yellow area is fenced from March 11 through April 1.
- The green area will be fenced from March 24 through March 28.
- The blue area will be fenced from March 25 through March 29 for the main stage.
- The pink area will only be closed off if necessary.

NOTE: Between March 11 and April 1, economy parkers will be able to park in any student lot around campus.
