The Ambassadors will be providing students with information on Monday August 24th and Tuesday August 25th about open parking spaces, the new cougar card, and bookstore services.

If you have any questions you can go to any of the following locations to receive answers to all your questions.

- **Welcome Center:** Ambassadors will provide information about parking services, parking permits online and required registration to obtain a parking permit.
- **Cougar One office in UC:** Ambassadors will distribute information about the new Cougar One cards and explain the difference between Cougar One cards and Higher One refund cards.
- **University Bookstore:** Ambassadors will demonstrate how to order textbooks through myUH (PeopleSoft) system as well as the availability of the Barnes & Nobles Scholarship and textbook loans.
- **Moody Towers and OB (residential dining halls):** Ambassadors will be assisting those students who experience problems with using their meal cards.
