### **TAN ROUTE – EASTWOOD/ERP LINE RE-ROUTED FOR EXPEDITED SERVICE**

Houston, August 17, 2009 – On August 17, 2009 the Cougar Line Tan Route will be routed to make stops at Eastwood Transit Center, the University Center and Energy Research Park (ERP) which is also known as University Business Park. The three stop route cycle is expected to take approximately 15 minutes.

Prior to today, the Tan route made several stops including PGH, Moores School of Music, Architecture, General Services, Athletic/ Alumni and Fleming. The compressed route will offer express service to campus for staff housed at ERP and students using the free parking lot located behind the staff parking spaces.

“Students are looking for more surface parking and we were fortunate to find space at ERP to accommodate approximately 500 spaces”, said Bob Browand, Director of Parking and Transportation. “With expanding free parking to this location and an increase in students using it, we needed to change the route to provide the quickest way to get students to campus.”
