STUDENT PARKING REGISTRATION NOW OPEN

Houston, July 13, 2009 – Students planning to drive their car to campus can now register for a parking permit using the new online registration page on the University Parking and Transportation website.

The new registration process no longer uses PeopleSoft and makes it faster and easier to register for a parking permit. To register, students will need to visit the Student Permit Registration link at www.uh.edu/parking and use their MyUH ID (PeopleSoft) number and their last name to log in.

To assist with using the new site Parking and Transportation posted an online demo to show students the online registration process step-by-step. The demo can be reached by clicking on the Student Permit Registration link.

Students can choose from student commuter parking, garage parking, economy parking, economy plus parking and residential housing exclusive parking. With the exception of students getting the residential housing exclusive (RHE) permit, all students must use the online parking registration process. Students are encouraged to decide on a type of parking permit and register early.

“The last thing a student needs to do the first week of class is worry about their parking permit. We encourage students to register for their parking permit today,” assistant director of parking and transportation Fidel Ramirez said. “Unlike previous years, the parking service counter at the UH Welcome Center will not be able to accept parking permit requests. All students who don’t get their permit by the start of school will be referred to a computer kiosk to register online.”

The parking service desk at the UH Welcome Center will be available to provide information and answer questions about permits and parking in general but students can expect to be directed to the online permit registration site. Parking and Transportation personnel plan to be out in force the first week of school to assist students needing to register for a permit.

Students registering before September 1, 2009, will have the option of picking up their permit at the Welcome Center or to have it mailed to the address specified during registration process. If students decide on picking up their permit, they will be notified when their permit is ready to be picked up. All students who choose to have their permit mailed will receive before parking enforcement period begins.
