## **Drill – Actions Following Explosion**

Task: Organize security and response operations following an explosion.

**Condition**: Given the aftermath of an explosion caused by an Improvised Explosive Device (IED) and/or Vehicle-Borne Improvised Explosive Device (VBIED) with multiple deaths and injuries, in an area where witnesses and bystanders are present.

**Standards:** Upon arrival at the incident scene, conduct size-up, establish incident command, secure the crime scene; and organize response.

## Performance Measures.

- 1. Conduct Size-Up.
- 2. Exercise caution. Balance the desire to help those injured with requirements for force protection.
- 3. Do not approach a presumed dead or wounded attackers as secondary commanddetonated devices or booby traps may be present
- 4. Scan the surrounding area for possible IEDs/VBIEDs or indications of potential follow-on attacks.
- 5. Establish Incident Command. Request resources as needed.
- 6. Designate a crime scene perimeter of sufficient standoff distance from the detonation to ensure protection from unexploded devices and the preservation of widely dispersed evidence
- 7. Provide Bomb Squad personnel initial access to the crime scene for purposes of inspection and clearing safe zones of operation for medical and related response.
- 8. Alert all personnel outside the crime scene perimeter to be aware of possible accomplices providing logistical support to those who may attempt to flee the area
- 9. Designate a medical triage area outside the crime scene perimeter
- 10. The Incident Commander shall designate supervisory or command officers as appropriate to manage the following functions
  - a. Force Protection
    - (1) In the absence of Bomb Techs, direct scan/search of the area for possible IED/VBIEDs positioned for follow-on attacks
    - (2) Conduct basic screening of emergency responders and others seeking access to the crime scene
    - (3) Perimeter security of the crime scene to identify possible criminal associates or collaborators

- (4) Control access to and perimeter security of the crime scene, medical triage area, emergency response staging area, and command posts
- (5) Position heavy vehicles to preclude potential vehicular follow-on attacks
- b. Bomb Detection and Safety
  - (1) Check the site of the explosion for undetonated or secondary explosive devices
  - (2) Coordinate with ATF and other agencies during the investigation and evidence recovery stages
- c. Medical and Coroner
  - (1) Move and treat the injured at the medical triage areas or transport to hospital(s) or medical surge site(s)
  - (2) Locate, transport, preserve, and identify human remains; locate and notify next-of-kin, and coordinate forensic-medical and law enforcement investigations
- d. Fire and Hazardous Materials
  - (1) Suppress fire and identify any hazardous materials emanating from or caused by the explosion.
