

**M. C. Sunny Wong, Ph.D.**

Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, University of San Francisco

Born in Hong Kong, Sunny Wong moved to the United States to pursue his higher education after he graduated in high school in 1995. He received his Bachelor of Science, Master of Science and Ph.D. degrees in Economics from the University of Oregon (1995-2002).

Prior to his current position at the University of San Francisco, he was an assistant professor at the University of Southern Mississippi (2002-2006). He is also an honorary instructor at the Essex Summer School in Social Science Data Analysis and Collection at the University of Essex in England. His teaching and research interests include monetary policy, learning dynamics, business-cycle theory, foreign direct investment and the empirical implications of theoretical models (EITM).

He has published research articles in academic journals including *Macroeconomic Dynamics*, *Economics Letters*, *Political Research Quarterly*, *Southern Economic Journal*, *Review of International Economics*, *Applied Economics*, and *Journal of Macroeconomics*. He recently published a book (coauthored with Dr. Jim Granato), *The Role of Policymakers in Business Cycle Fluctuations* (Cambridge University Press) in April 2006.
