A minimum of 2.00 cumulative GPA in all UH coursework attempted is required for graduation. Transfer and test credits are not calculated into the UH GPA. Grades from courses that were repeated will be factored into the GPA, but the original letter grade will not be replaced.	
A minimum 120 hours of coursework are required to earn a degree. A minimum of 150 hours of coursework are required for a double degree. Of those hours, 36 hours must be advanced or junior/senior level (3000/4000). * Note remedial, repeated, and any courses excluded by the department or CLASS will not be considered towards the total hours required for the degree.
