

WGSS Graduate Student Travel Grant Application

UH graduate students currently enrolled in a master's or doctoral program at the University of Houston may apply for a limited number of supplemental travel funds in order to facilitate travel to professional conferences or for research projects on WGSS topics. Preference will be given to students who have completed or are currently enrolled in at least one course toward the Women's Studies Graduate Certificate, but students need not be enrolled in the WS Graduate Certificate program in order to apply. The maximum amount awarded per student will be \$750.

Awards will be made in the Fall and Spring semesters. Any student wishing to apply for summer funding should submit a request by the Spring semester deadline. The deadline is April 15, 2016 for students wishing to receive funding retroactively for Spring 2016 or for Summer 2016. The deadline is September 30, 2016 for students wishing to receive funding retroactively for Fall 2016 or for Spring 2017.

To apply for this travel grant, please complete the following:

- **WGSS Graduate Student Travel Grant Application form:** This form is attached to this sheet and can also be found on the WGSS Program website. This form must be completed in full and submitted by the deadline.
- **Current CV:** A current curriculum vitae must be included in your application materials.
- **Description of project:** In one typed page, please explain the project for which you are requesting funds and how this project relates to WGSS. The description should include the following information:
 - For conferences, the name of the conference, location, and your role in it. Please specify if you will be presenting a paper or attending. If presenting a paper, please include a brief abstract. Please explain how your participation in this conference relates to women's, gender and/or sexuality studies.
 - For research projects, please fully explain the proposed project and how your participation relates to women's, gender and/or sexuality studies.
- **Full budget:** Please include a full budget for the proposed conference travel or project, specifying any funding expected from other sources, both inside and outside the university.
