

Referrals for Assessment of ADHD, LD, Autism

(includes providers who assess for professional exam accommodations)

Let the evaluator know the following when you discuss what is needed for your evaluation

CSD @ University of Houston

1. Take documentation requirements with you when discussing and attending the evaluation appointment
 - a. ADHD - http://www.uh.edu/csd/documentation/add_adhd.html
 - b. LD - http://www.uh.edu/csd/documentation/learning_disabilities.html
 - c. Autism - http://www.uh.edu/csd/documentation/psychological_disorders.html
2. Take any prior evaluation documentation with you to assist the evaluator gaining a complete educational background
3. Take any current accommodation documentation with you if you have a 504 plan, an Individual Education Plan, or postsecondary accommodations

SAT, ACT, GRE, GMAT, LSAT, Praxis, NCLEX and other standardized entrance/certification examinations

1. Carefully examine the testing company's website for the following guidelines
 - a. General testing policies
 - b. General requests for accommodations
 - c. Specific condition accommodation documentation requirements

- Assessment for Autism Spectrum Disorders (Autism, Asperger's syndrome) – uses ADOS-2
- Neuropsychologist on staff so neuropsychological assessments are available

Fees

- Does not accept insurance
- Does not offer a sliding scale
- No flat fee for testing: assessment is individualized. Initial interview determines the assessment(s) needed and the cost.
 - Initial clinical interview - \$225.00
 - AD/HD and ADD assessments – range from \$325 to \$2080
 - Learning disability assessments – range from \$320 - \$2080
 - Neuropsychological evaluations – range from \$2080 and up
