CUR is calling for students to submit an abstract of their research that represents any of CUR's disciplinary divisions (Arts and Humanities, Biology, Chemistry, Geosciences, Mathematics/Computer Science, Physics/Astronomy, Psychology, and Social Sciences).

To be considered for the UH Posters on the Hill Travel Grant, interested students and mentors must email Karen Weber ([kweber@uh.edu](mailto:kweber@uh.edu)) **no later than Friday, November 6, 2009** to notify her of your plans to submit an abstract. The deadline for submission of applications to CUR for the Spring 2010 event is **Tuesday, November 10, 2009**.

To encourage participation from the University of Houston, travel support will be provided for the student and his/her UH faculty mentor who is selected by CUR to represent the University of Houston. The faculty mentor must be a UH faculty member and the primary advisor on the student's undergraduate research project. Abstracts and recommendation letters must be submitted online to CUR according to the instructions on the Posters on the Hill website.

Student travel support will be provided by the Office of Undergraduate Discovery and faculty mentor travel support will be provided by the Provost's Office. Travel support will include economical round-trip airfare, lodging, meals and is limited no more than \$2,000 per person for one UH student and his/her mentor who is selected by CUR to represent UH at the Posters on the Hill 2010 event.

- Travel support will be available for one student and his/her mentor to represent UH at the 2010 Posters on the Hill.
