They include grants and projects that are longer than, shorter than, or otherwise not in conformity with the state fiscal year beginning and ending dates. In PS, they will use Budget Period BP0000 because no specific budget period is applicable. In FRS, these type accounts have a Year-End Process flag of 'P' on SL's and 'Y' on GL's. Project ID's carry all the detail of programs, plus much more. (When a Project ID will be assigned, we will use a generic Program Code with it.) All project type FRS accounts were converted to unique PS Project ID's. In the case of one-to-one mapping between a GL &amp; SL, the pair only received one Project ID. The code either starts with an alpha of 'G' for grant related activities, a 'P' for plant &amp; capital project activities, or an 'A' for administrative projects (no 'A's currently assigned).</p>
