In the 1940's and 1950's an incredible event took place at the University of Houston. Students, campus organizations and community businesses gathered their expertise and talents to build an event that attracted as many as 100,000 people to the UH campus. It attracted celebrities and visitors from all over the nation to the largest college event in the country. In fact, one year it was featured in *Life magazine* as the "greatest college show on earth."

Now in 2008, forty-five years after the festival was discontinued and over a decade since its revival, the University of Houston invites the community to join in its celebration once again. Frontier Fiesta celebrates everything that makes the University of Houston important to the Houston community today — the diversity of its students, the outstanding faculty and staff, and its supportive alumni. Last year's Frontier Fiesta attracted nearly 30,000 people; this year promises continuing growth and excitement.

The 2008 Frontier Fiesta will be held March 27th, through March 29th. Events will include live music, Broadway-style shows, a parade, carnival booths, a cook-off and a scholarship competition. This year we plan to offer eight scholarships — four for University of Houston undergraduates and four for high school seniors.

Applicants are asked to submit the following:

1. Completed Community Involvement Application
2. A 500-word essay describing the student's activities in the community.
3. List of interests and activities
4. Two letters of recommendation from individuals associated with your community involvement

General Requirements

The following requirements apply to students applying for either scholarship:

1. Students **must** attend the University of Houston in the Fall 2008 semester
2. Students may apply for **either or both** scholarships

Students are **required** to submit all materials in one envelope. Incomplete packages **will not** be considered.
