PRIOR DEGREE VERIFICATION HOLDS

- PDV holds for have been lifted for Spring 2023 admitted international students.
- A email has been sent to all other students with PDV holds instructing them to provide the required academic documents to the Graduate School.
- Transcript analysts will be at the Graduate School Office, E Cullen Rm 102 from 9 am-3 pm M-F to accept academic documents.
- If students are unsure of which academic documents are required to remove the hold, they can contact the Graduate School at gradschool@uh.edu
- Petitions to grant extra time to provide required academic documents will need to be sent to graduate school for students who currently have PDV holds but still lack documents to verify their degree.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY AUTOMATED WAIVER PROCESS

- Applicants who qualify for an English language proficiency waiver (ELP) based on country of earned academic credentials can request this through the ApplyWeb application.
- Through our updated automated process the departments will no longer need to review and manually approved these waiver in ApplyWeb (similarly to how GRE waivers based on GPA are approved.
- ELP requirements will automatically be waived once an application has been submitted and degree verified through receipt of required academic documents from applicants from qualifying ELP waiver countries except Canada (the Graduate School will manually review).


