Curtis W. Huff is the President and Chairman of Freebird Partners, a private investment firm focused on energy, biotechnology and renewable technology. Huff is also the Chairman of the Board of Patterson-UTI, a leading US provider of oilfield services. He co-founded Intervale Capital, an oilfield service private equity firm, and serves as an advisor to Energy Innovation Capital, a private equity firm that focuses on transitional energy technologies. Huff also served as the President and Chief Executive Officer of Grant Prideco, Inc., a provider of oilfield drilling products, and as Executive Vice President, Chief Financial Officer and General Counsel of Weatherford International, Inc., one of the world's largest international oilfield services companies.

Huff grew up in New Mexico and is a graduate of the University of New Mexico, having received a BA in Economics and Political Science from the University of New Mexico and a JD from the New Mexico School of Law, where he graduated cum laude. He received a Masters of Law from New York University School of Law. Huff began his career with the international law firm of Norton Rose Fulbright US LLP in Houston, Texas, where he practiced for 15 years and specialized in corporate, securities and merger and acquisition matters.

Huff served as the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the University of St. Thomas in Houston, serving on its board for over ten years and founding its Rising Stars internship program for first-generation students. Huff is involved with various charities and organizations, including the University of St. Thomas Houston, the Houston Food Bank, the Houston Ballet, Interfaith Ministries for Greater Houston, the Hobby School of Public Affairs, Casa Juan Diego and the St. Christus Foundation for Healthcare in Houston.
