Learning Abroad requires UH faculty-led programs to have in-country logistics providers in order to ensure adequate safety and risk support.

It is our role to ensure they are **adequately insured and vet their in-country transportation** options, that they will **support 24/7 in-country**, that they can **support changes to housing and transportation** needs.

When considering a logistics provider please review:

- Contact Details
 - Who is your contact person(s) with the organization?
- What in-country support is provided?
 - o How do they provide risk and safety support?
 - o How can they support in crisis management?
 - Are they available 24/7 in case of an emergency?
- Housing Details
 - o How is housing chosen?
 - o How do they assign students to housing?
- Transportation Details
 - o How are transportation services chosen?
 - O How are these services vetted?
- Is there any visa and immigration support?
