

The University of Houston is the doctoral degree-granting and largest university of the University of Houston System, a public system of higher education that includes three other universities (UH-Clear Lake, UH-Downtown, and UH-Victoria).



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## **Executive Summary**

The Fall 2023 International Student Enrollment Report shows continued and consistent international student population with a growing pool of international students on post-completion OPT that rose almost 30%. The population of non-immigrant students at UH has recovered to almost the same population as in 2016 and is continuing on the trend to surpass the highest total non-immigration population in 2015 by next year. For our reporting system in SEVIS, the overall records maintained has increased 8.5% while the overall international F-1 student enrollment has increased by about 1%. SEVIS records were over 5,500 in 2019 and dropped to the lowest since 2011 in 2020 at 4,763 students. As of fall 2023, these numbers are back up to 5,833. SEVIS tracks F1 students and alumni, F-2 dependents, and J1 scholars and their J-2 dependents. The highest percentage of increase were in F-1 students on OPT, J-1 scholars and F-2 dependents which each in double digit increases.

The top ten sending countries to UH has remained the same. Both Pakistan and Bangladesh are showing a significant increase of international students with growths of 22.1% and 31.4% respectively. The international student population from India increased 2.4%, going from 1,383 to 1,416 and remains the highest population by a large amount. Nigeria, Iran, and Canada also increased their sending populations at a good rate compared to last year. Vietnam has overtook China in 2022 as the number 2 sending country with 353 students, even though both countries had a decrease of students in the past two years. China's decline continues to drop at an alarming rate with a 16.8% decrease.

The newly admitted students for fall 2023 saw a rise of 4.6% for graduate students, but a decline of 15.6% for undergraduates. The newly admitted graduate numbers are at an all time high with 906 admitted compared to 866 last year. The College of Technology(now the College of Engineering - Technology Division) had one of the largest declines of admitted students from last year with a 30.3% decline. Most of the other colleges have remained close to similar levels but with small decreases due to the undergraduate admission numbers regressing to the 2021 total.

The F-1 alumni population on OPT bounced back from last year as the 2021 graduating students are starting to move into the work authorization period of their F-1 status. The numbers went from 1,181 (lowest since 2015) to 1,527 and almost broke the all-time high set in 2018. The numbers will increase for the coming years as it adjusts to the increase of enrollment in the past couple years. The biggest increase in the population of alumni on OPT was with graduate students in their first year which refers to Post-Completion OPT and it broke the all-time high set in 2016. Once these alumni transitions into the additional two-year STEM Extension period, it will push the population on OPT to over 2,000 in the coming years. As predicted, the rebound from 2022 has come and will improve the number of alumni that ISSSO serves for the following

The J-1 population has grown significantly as well, as UH is beginning to invite more researchers and J-1 students to the campus. The overall population growth is up 7.5% which can be attributed mostly to the Research Scholar category. We are seeing much higher numbers and with the collaboration of the Higher Educational Commission in Pakistan and better research prestige and faculty across the board.

The overall numbers for international students and scholars are looking much stronger than in previous years as the University continues to strive to broaden its horizon.




## Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) Report

#### What is SEVIS?

The Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) is a U.S. government internet-based system that tracks current information on non-immigrant students (F and M visas), exchange visitors (J visa), and their dependents (F-2, M-2, and J-2). SEVIS allows schools and program sponsors to transmit electronic information and event notifications via the internet to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and U.S. Department of State (DOS) throughout the student's/exchange visitor's stay in the United States. SEVIS reflects changes in international student or exchange visitor status, admission at the Port of Entry (POE), changes of address, changes in program of study, employment authorizations, and other events. Immigration forms I-20 (F visas) and DS-2019 (J visas) are also issued through SEVIS.

The International Student and Scholar Services Office (ISSSO) was responsible for maintaining records in SEVIS for students, scholars, faculty, and dependents for the Fall 2023 semester that totals 5,833.









## By Gender







## By Average Age Over Time

















#### 25 Year Regional Trends: Oceania\*




# 25 Year Non-Immigrant Enrollment Trends by Region



# Fall 2023 Curricular Pratical Training (CPT) Report

Curricular Pratical Training (CPT) is an opportunity for non-immigrant students to gain pratical work experience that is an integral part of their degree program. In order to be eligible for CPT, a department would either have to opt in for the experience track subplan and enroll in the University's COOP program, take a course that is part of the degree program and requires an internship or practicum experience to receive a grade, or be an essential part of a student's dissertation. CPT's are authorized per semester and a new application has to be approved for any subsequent semester that a student wishes to continue doing their practical training.





### F-1 Employment Statistics: Optional Practical Training (OPT)

Non-immigrant students on the F-1 visa have the option of pursuing a 12-month employment benefit, immediately following completion of their degree program. The student must apply with the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) for permission to work. The student is able to accept employment that is directly related to her/his major area of study for a specified time period, upon approval. This time period is referred to as Optional Practical Training (OPT). Students graduating from certain science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) disciplines designated by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security may be eligible for an additional 24-month extension for a combined 36 months of OPT. There are 1,527 F-1 alumni from 86 nations that participated in Optional Practical Training during Fall 2023.



#### Open Doors Report Explanation

The next few pages contain information specific to International Student and Scholar Services Office's yearly reporting data to the Institute of International Education's (IIE) Open Door report. It depicts non-immigrant enrollment counts by country of origin and field of study for the Fall 2023 semester at the University of Houston. Field of study designations were determined based on the Classification of Instructional Program (CIP) Codes associated with the student's primary major. These codes are not specific to a certain college, and should not be compared in the same way. The following tables identify the trends for the top 25 sending countries to the U.S. for school year 2022/2023 and what role of incoming students UH has had for these sending countries and the current enrollment data that will be sent for fall 2023.

This page contains information regarding enrollment rank of the top 25 countries in the U.S. and how many of these students study at UH while the following two pages have information regarding the CIP code designations. As you will note, the top 25 sending countries to the U.S. are not the same as the top countries that are enrolled at the University of Houston. Iran, Nigeria, Mexico, Pakistan, and Colombia, for example, are higher ranked on the list for UH, but not in the entire U.S. On the opposite end, Brazil, Germany, Japan, Indonesia, UK, Hong Kong, and Kuwait are in the top twenty-five sending countries to the U.S., but has a small student population at UH.







# **J-1 Program Participation over the Past 10 Years**






### Language and Culture Center Enrollment: Fall 2023


The Language and Culture Center (LCC) is located on the University of Houston campus and provides students the ability to experience life at an American university while learning English as a Second Language (ESL) through a variety of courses designed to integrate them into the American educational system. LCC has provided intensive English instruction for international students on the University of Houston campus since 1975. LCC students may apply for admission to UH upon successful completion of the sixth and final level and passing TOEFL scores. Students enrolled in LCC programs are not enrolled in degree-seeking courses at UH and are therefore not included in the international student enrollment figures indicated earlier in this report. During the fall term of 2023, international students and permanent residents from 15 nations participated in the LCC program.
