- Connect with pharmacists, professors, TAs, and academic advisors

- **PharmCAS application goes live July 18<sup>th</sup>**
- Start application process
- Confirm with people writing your letters of recommendation
- **July 11<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> PCAT test days**
- International priority deadline: August 1<sup>st</sup>

- **Early Decision Deadline is: September 4<sup>th</sup>**
- Finish your application and submitting items
- **September 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> PCAT test days**
- On-site interviews begin
- October 22<sup>nd</sup>-November 2<sup>nd</sup> PCAT test days
- Final Deadline is: January 7<sup>th</sup>
