This Radiation Safety Manual is not intended to be an exhaustive or fully comprehensive reference, but rather a guide for Principal Investigators and Authorized Users. Further advice concerning hazards associated with specific radioactive material, radiation producing devices, and/or the development of new or unfamiliar procedures should be obtained through consultation with the Radiation Safety Officer.

The Radiation Safety Manual is an enforceable component of the Radioactive Material Broad Scope License and Radiation Producing Devices Registrations under which the University of Houston is authorized.
