Campus Incidents

08-0019 – Theft – 1/9/08 1:22 p.m. – Farish Hall – Adams – A student checked out a test kit to complete her course at the College of Education. Staff members sent the student messages requesting the return of the test kit and the kit has not been returned. Occurred between 8/30/07 and 1/9/08.
