Campus Incidents

08-0471 – Theft – 4/24/08 8:23 a.m. – Parking Garage 1 – Landin – A student reported that a friend stole her cell phone. The cell phone was recovered and the individual was issued a criminal trespass warning, arrested and transported to Harris County Jail. The incident occurred between 8:20 a.m. and 8:23 a.m. 4/24/08.
