Basic Patrol Rifle Course (Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) #3322)

Course Description:

This course is designed to provide the front-line officer with the basic knowledge and skills needed to safely deploy the AR-15 style Service Rifle in appropriate patrol response situations.

Currently commissioned Texas Peace Officers

Required Equipment:

- Hearing and Eye Protection
- AR15-type Rifle: Semi-Automatic 223/ 556 caliber with A1/A2-type sights manufactured by a manufacturer approved by your Agency.
- Three (3) Magazines in 20 or 30 round capacity
- Rifle sling Iron sights are required as learning how to zero metallic sights is a course objective. OPTIONAL red dot display aiming device in addition to the iron sights are permissible. The student is required to bring their patrol duty belt and on-duty carry handgun to learn and execute transition drills of fire. Ammunition needs are 100 rounds of ammo for the same. 400 rounds .556/.223 ammunition that the rifle is safely designed to use and manufactured under S.A.M.I. manufacturing standards. No steel penetrator, tracer rounds, or reloaded ammunition allowed.

- Drinking Water, Snacks and Lunch are highly recommended

24 hours TCOLE credit awarded for successful class completion. TCOLE credit will be entered by the University of Houston Police Department.
