ONLINE STUDENT REGISTRATION IS NOW REQUIRED

Houston, July 21, 2009 – The University of Houston Parking and Transportation Services department has adopted a new policy that requires all students to register online for their parking permits starting with the Fall 2009 semester.

The department is currently coordinating a comprehensive marketing campaign that includes sending targeted emails and postcards to all registered students alerting them of the change in policy.

The new policy requires all permits except for RHE permits to be purchased online. The students will then be given the choice to have the permits mailed to their local address or the option to pick up the permit from the Welcome Center's Parking Services desk.

All students that do not register online and come to the Parking Services desk will be required to use one of the computer kiosks at the Welcome Center Garage to register for their parking permit.

All student permit fees will be placed on the student's Fee Bill and will be payable through the MyUH (PeopleSoft) website, the Parking Services desk will no longer accept payment for student permits. Students that wish to pay with Cash, Check or Money Order will need to visit the Student Financial Services Cashier at the Welcome Center to make a payment.

PLANNING TO PARK ON CAMPUS? ONLINE REGISTRATION IS NOW MANDATORY!

Unlike previous years, permits will only be sold online this year. All students that come to the Parking Services Desk will be referred to a computer kiosk to register online. What are you waiting for? Student parking registration is now open at www.uh.edu/parking.

2. Enter your MyUH ID (PeopleSoft):

4. Select a Parking Permit.
5. Select the vehicle you want to register.
6. Select to have permit mailed or picked up.
