UH TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING ADVISORY COMMITTEE (TPAC) ISSUES FY 2010 PARKING RATE RECOMMENDATIONS

Houston, March 17, 2009 – The University of Houston Transportation and Parking Advisory Committee (TPAC), a group comprised of students, faculty and staff, has released their annual recommendation for parking fees. The members, all appointed, have been chosen from within their representative bodies – the Student Government Association (SGA), the Faculty Senate and Staff Council. TPAC has worked diligently during the Fall (2008) and Spring (2009) semesters to present this comprehensive recommendation to the administration.

In addition to recommending future parking rates on campus, the document also outlines the future of parking facilities at the University of Houston. With the current and upcoming construction of on-campus housing and academic facilities, METRO Rail and a new End Zone facility for Robertson Stadium, parking on campus will need to move towards more campus garages and using public transportation to accommodate everyone's needs.

Lastly, the recommendation includes upgrades to existing parking facilities that include paving two current gravel lots and improving lighting of parking lots around campus.
