More Parking Options for the Fall Semester

Houston, September 11– The five hundred student parking spots that are currently available at Energy Research Park (ERP) will continue to be open for the remainder of the Fall semester. No permit is required to park at ERP. The Eastwood/ERP Cougar Line shuttle route passes through Energy Research Park every 15 minutes from 7am to 6:45pm and goes directly to the University Center. The Cougar Line shuttle is a free service, please visit <http://www.uh.edu/pts/aroundarrival.htm> for exact arrival times. Energy Research Park is located at 5000 Gulf Freeway just off the 45 South Feeder Road past Spur 5 and will be on your right. The property sign currently says, University Business Park.

Wheeler Avenue Baptist Church and the S3 Lot near TSU are also still open to students as free parking options.

Students with an RHE permit, please do not park in the commuter lots. RHE lots are exclusive to residence. Every time a car with an RHE permit is moved to a commuter parking space, another student loses a spot. RHE permits are permitted in student commuter parking lots after 5pm Monday through Friday. Parking Enforcement will be enforcing the rule and those with a RHE permit parking in a commuter area will be subject to citation.
