2009-2010 Student Parking Registration opens July 1, 2009

Houston, July 1, 2009 - Parking and Transportation Services is pleased to announce our new on-line parking registration site at www.uh.edu/parking. This means that students will no longer use MyUH (PeopleSoft) to register for their parking permit. To register go to www.uh.edu/parking and click on the "Student Permit Registration" link.

To assist you in using the new site we have created an online demonstration that takes you step by step through the registration process. To access the demo clip click on the "Student Permit Registration" link and then click on "Click here for instructions".

Students registering for any permit other than a Resident Hall Exclusive are required to use the online parking registration process. Residents of Moody Towers, the Quadrangle, Cougar Place, and Calhoun Lofts wishing to purchase Resident Hall permits will receive a separate correspondence explaining their parking registration process.

Online student parking registration for 2009-2010 parking permits starts July 1, 2009, and will run throughout the academic year. Students registering before September 1, 2009, will have the option of having their permits mailed to the address specified during registration or to pick up their permit from the Parking Services Window at the Welcome Center Garage. Starting on September 1, 2009, and continuing through the fall semester, all permits must be ordered online and picked up at the Welcome Center Garage.
