
# Homeless Youth with Histories of Involvement with Juvenile Probation Findings from YouthCount 2.0!

## LIFETIME HISTORY OF DIAGNOSES

56%	Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder
60%	Bipolar
60%	Depression
22%	Conduct Disorder or Oppositional Defiant Disorder
28%	Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder
18%	Schizophrenia



### **SOCIAL SUPPORT**



Reported there is no adult in the community they can go to for job or school advice



Reported there is no adult they can go to for emotional support



Say there is no adult in their life who cares about them
