Assistant Field Coordinator: Casper Campus (Position Number 2627): Applications for an academic professional position at the assistant lecturer or associate lecturer level at the <u>University of Wyoming/Casper Campus</u> location, beginning summer or fall, 2011, are requested. Social workers with experience in field coordination or field liaison in undergraduate social work are encouraged to apply.

The *University of Wyoming* is a Carnegie research-doctoral extensive institution. The Division of Social Work offers a baccalaureate social work program at the University of Wyoming/Casper Campus (UW/CC), located approximately 2 ½ hours from the main Laramie campus. The Laramie campus also administers a BSW and an Advanced Generalist MSW program, enrolling approximately 130 undergraduate and 60 graduate students. The Division has a strong focus on social work within rural communities. The *Division of Social Work* has a collaborative record of research and scholarship within the College of Health Sciences.

The University of Wyoming is the state's only provider of baccalaureate and graduate education. The University of Wyoming/Casper College campus allows access for social work students who live in the central Wyoming area. The university maintains outreach centers across Wyoming, providing excellent opportunities for community practice, social research and development.

<u>Requirements</u> include an MSW from a CSWE-accredited institution, two years of post-MSW practice experience. Doctorate preferred. Applicants must show clear evidence of potential for excellence in teaching, student field education, student advising, and outreach and service. Applicants must have university teaching and field experience. Preference will be given to applicants who have experience with distance education programs and an interest in rural social work practice.

<u>Responsibilities</u> include teaching in a range of BSW classes, possibly teaching MSW classes, and managing field placements in the northern and central Wyoming regions. Committee and community service, administrative duties for the coordination of the Casper campus with UW/CC personnel, student advisement, and field liaison assignments are required. The position requires evening teaching assignments and some travel. On-line teaching and use of other distance formats are used in this program.
