Job Description:

The School of Social Work, Hawai'i Pacific University, invites applications for 1 full-time, visiting faculty position at the rank of Assistant/Associate or Full Professor for a nine-month appointment to begin Fall 2011 with the possibility of renewal for up to three years. Successful applicants will be expected to teach a combination of 24 credits (typically 8 classes) in the Master of Social Work program. Faculty members are expected to participate in University and community service, other departmental activities, assessment of learning outcomes, student advising and professional development, and scholarly activities.

Courses are offered in the evenings and on Saturdays. Hawai'i Pacific University faculty are expected to be excellent teachers, intellectually engaged in their discipline and its scholarship, and participating members of the University/School, professional, and local communities.

Minimum qualifications: Candidates for the position should have a Master degree in Social Work from an accredited program by the Council on Social Work Education with a minimum of two years of practice experience.

Desired Qualifications: A doctorate in Social Work or related field is preferred. The ideal candidate will have two or more years of teaching experience at the adjunct or full-time faculty level, a willingness and interest in developing and delivering courses via web-based distance learning technology.

The successful applicant must also demonstrate a sincere interest and ability in teaching in a multicultural environment, a promising record of scholarship, and a desire to involve graduate students in research. The successful applicant should also have an interest and/or demonstrated record of active involvement in faculty/student extracurricular activities (e.g., club organizations, program-wide presentations), program review, student advising and community service.
