The University of Arkansas at Monticello (UAM) ([www.uamont.edu/jobs](http://www.uamont.edu/jobs)) is seeking applicants for a twelve-month tenure track position with academic rank awarded commensurate with experience. UAM, one of eleven campuses of the University of Arkansas System, is located in southeastern Arkansas in the beautiful timberlands, rich in outdoor recreation activities, and approximately 100 miles south of Little Rock. UAM is a comprehensive, residential and commuter, undergraduate institution also offering selected master degree programs.

**Responsibilities:** Duties include teaching two courses each semester, student advising, faculty oversight, student recruitment and retention efforts. Administrative responsibilities also include accreditation oversight and maintenance, and budget management.

**Qualifications:** An MSW degree, doctorate preferred, from a CSWE accredited Social Work program and a minimum of five years social work practice experience is required. Experience in and evidence of quality classroom teaching. Priority will be given to candidates who have previously worked closely with successful CSWE accreditation or reaccreditation. Experience in teaching research methodology is also desirable. Preference will be given to those candidates who strive to be master teachers, able to teach across the Social Work curriculum, have a history of maintaining strong community relations, and can demonstrate successful university or Social Work administrative experience.
