


# MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY

### Assistant Professor Tenure Track Position



The Michigan State University School of Social Work in the College of Social Science is seeking applications for an Assistant Professor to complement and enhance active research areas in the School. The faculty engage in research with diverse content areas including gerontology, child welfare, and health/mental health. The research environment at MSU is one that encourages collaboration among disciplines and across colleges. We seek a colleague who is research active with a beginning record of scholarship and a clear plan for continued research activity.

MSU is a land-grant, Carnegie RU/VH, AAU, global university located in East Lansing, Michigan, near the state capital. The School is dedicated to educating students for competent, responsive, and ethical social work practice. Our teaching, research, and outreach seek to promote positive change and social justice for diverse communities, organizations, groups, families, and individuals. More than 500 students are enrolled in our CSWE-accredited BASW and MSW programs, and PhD program.

The School supports MSU's outreach mission through off-campus, distance, and blended instructional programs that utilize technology and innovative teaching strategies. We also provide multiple opportunities for creative interdisciplinary teaching and research, community-based studies, and partnerships with government agencies and neighborhoods.

**Responsibilities:** The successful candidate will work with faculty and students to implement the land-grant mission at MSU through the following:

- Sustain an active program of scholarship as evidenced by peer reviewed publications and professional presentations
- Pursue and secure external funding to support a focused program of research
- Teach and mentor diverse students in the School's programs
- Participate in School, College, and University governance activities
- Add intellectual diversity and cultural richness to the School

**Required Qualifications:**

- An earned doctorate in Social Work or closely related field, completed by August 1, 2015
- A record of scholarly publications

**Desired Qualifications:**

- At least one Social Work degree
- A record of outreach and service and/or experience in teaching

**Appointment:** This is a 9-month tenure track position beginning August 2015. Salary for this position is negotiable and commensurate with the candidate's qualifications and experience. **Application Procedure:** Applicants are asked to submit a curriculum vitae along with a letter detailing qualifications and interest in the position; commitment to diversity; a description of their program of research; and a reflection on their fit with the School, College, and University. Applicants must also submit three letters of reference and two samples of their written work.

Review of applications will begin immediately, with screening interviews planned for CSWE APM in Tampa, Florida, October 23-26.
