TWO TENURE-TRACK ASSISTANT PROFESSOR FACULTY POSITIONS IN SOCIAL WORK, Position # 32241 and # 38134 FALL 2014

The University of Central Florida (UCF) is a metropolitan public research university located in Orlando, Florida. As a part of the State University System of Florida, with the enrollment of approximately 60,000 students it is reported to be the second-largest university in the United States. The main campus is located approximately 13 miles from the historic, vibrant and ethnically diverse downtown Orlando and close to one of the most ecologically pristine coastal regions in the world. UCF is home to twelve colleges and eleven regional campuses throughout Central Florida. The School of Social Work serves approximately 750 students in the clinical graduate program and in the undergraduate program. The School of Social Work is in the College of Health and Public Affairs, providing a collegial and supportive environment that fosters interdisciplinary and community-based research and service. UCF has a diverse and international student body.

The University of Central Florida (UCF) School of Social Work invites applications for two (2) tenure track faculty positions, both at the rank of assistant professor.

Responsibilities include: teaching, research, and service. Particular areas of research and teaching expertise may include, but are not limited to: gerontology, health, child welfare, mental health, military social work, and health disparities. There is opportunity to teach in the B.S.W. program and the M.S.W. program and to work with doctoral students in the Social Work track of the interdisciplinary Public Affairs Doctoral Program in the College of Health and Public Affairs.

The individual selected will be expected to meet the requirements for tenure and promotion at UCF, which includes developing a focused and funded research agenda.

There may be opportunities to earn additional income from summer employment. This nine-month faculty position reports to the director of the School of Social Work, in the College of Health and Public Affairs at the University of Central Florida. UCF's School of Social Work is particularly committed to having a diverse faculty.

Salary is contingent upon experience and qualifications. Screening will begin upon receipt of applications. Application deadline is January 30, 2014.

Required: M.S.W. degree from a CSWE-accredited institution and a D.S.W. or Ph.D. in social work or a related discipline from an accredited institution. Teaching experience at either the M.S.W. or B.S.W. level. Applicants at the rank of assistant professor must demonstrate strong research capacity.

Preferred: A beginning publication record in an area of specialization; current funding or evidence of potential for external funding; online teaching experience; and two years of post-master's practice experience. Previous experience with online teaching is strongly desired.
