Responsibilities will include leading the development and implementation of an MSW curriculum, teaching in the program, maintaining a scholarly agenda, and providing service to the campus and community.

Qualifications: A Master of Social Work degree is required. A Ph.D. in Social Work or a related field is strongly preferred, as are three to five years experience teaching social work and two to three years of administrative experience in a BSW or MSW program.
