**Job Description:** St. Catherine University and the University of St. Thomas are accepting applications for a full-time tenure track faculty position in the School of Social Work. The BSW program has been accredited since 1974 and the MSW program has been accredited since 1990. The BSW Program offers day and weekend options. The MSW Program offers evening and weekend cohort options. This is a thriving school with approximately 615 students and is well respected in the practice community. It offers innovative programs that strive to meet community needs. In March 2012, US News and World Report ranked the School as one of the top schools of social work in the country, in the top 25% of all schools. The vibrant and ethnically diverse cities of Minneapolis and St. Paul are well known for their cultural and social amenities and have been consistently named one of the most livable metropolitan areas in the US.

St. Catherine University in St. Paul/Minneapolis is a comprehensive Catholic university with the nation's largest college for women at its center. The School of Social Work invites applicants for an entry level full-time tenure track ranked faculty position beginning in Fall 2013.

Responsibilities: 9-month faculty position with primary responsibility to our graduate programs (evening and weekend cohort) with teaching in the undergraduate program when needed. The graduate faculty will teach primarily in the generalist practice, social policy, supervision, and research curriculum areas. Faculty are expected to teach six courses per academic year. Other faculty responsibilities include student advising, committee assignments, clinical research paper advising, professional activities of research, presentation and publication, and program, school, university and community service.

**Qualifications:** St. Catherine and St. Thomas are private, Roman Catholic institutions. We seek candidates who are comfortable with and can contribute to the mission of our Catholic institutions, which are committed to the total development of the individual student. Both Universities have strong commitments to the principles of diversity and inclusion, to equal opportunity policies and practices, and to the principles and goals of affirmative action. Ability to articulate a diverse/multicultural perspective required. Classroom experience in accredited social work program preferred.
