Job Description: The Department of Social Work at Wright State University seeks candidates for the position of Instructor beginning August 16, 2012. The salary is competitive at the Instructor level. Wright State is a medium sized, state-supported university (over 19,000 students) in southwestern Ohio, located in suburban Dayton and near Columbus and Cincinnati. The vision of Wright State University is: "In the pioneering spirit of the Wright Brothers, Wright State will be Ohio's most innovative university, known and admired for our diversity and for the transformative impact we have on the lives of our students and on the communities we serve." The Department of Social Work is growing! We offer an undergraduate social work degree accredited by the Council on Social Work Education since 1974 and reaffirmed in 2010. Wright State faculty have taught graduate level classes toward an MSW degree at The Ohio State University since 2006 and have been approved to apply for candidacy with CSWE and have begun a collaborative MSW program with Miami University beginning Fall 2012. Wright State University and the Social Work Department are dedicated to building on and expanding on the strengths of diverse student, faculty, and staff populations. Student development programs include a Gerontology Certificate program and a federally funded child welfare training program.
