Experience in mental health services preferred; • Knowledge about community resources and social services; • Training in suicide prevention and crisis intervention; • Demonstration of clinical competence in at least one primary area of practice (ACT certification, Gottman certification, RPT, certified in EMDR, CPT, etc.) within 2 years of hire; • Knowledge and experience in identification and reporting of abuse, neglect, or exploitation of children, the elderly, or persons with disability; • Strong public speaking and writing skills; • Proven interpersonal skills and effective as a member of a team; • Ability to maintain relationships with client base and community stakeholders; • Proficient in the use of EHRs; • Must maintain professional licensure appropriate to provide clinical services; • Must maintain professional liability insurance; • Must pass comprehensive background check; and, • Must have driver's license and reliable transportation, and be insurable. • Preferred: bilingual; Veteran; social worker; ability to treat: substance use issues, eating disorders, Veterans & families; TBI, & personality disorders
