<b>Job Description</b>	The Addiction Treatment Specialist is responsible for completing comprehensive assessments of persons whose lives are disrupted or complicated by substance abuse issues, conducting individual and group therapy sessions in an outpatient setting, communicating with patients, family members and others with the admission process, assisting with both voluntary and involuntary court-ordered treatment, making referrals to other community resources as appropriate, assigning persons in need of treatment to the appropriate level of care as needed, coordinating AA/NA groups, managing one clinical therapist and one administrative assistant, and assisting the marketing department with the promotion of the program. The Addiction Treatment Specialist is expected to function as a member of the multidisciplinary team and participate in the organization's community relations program as well as participate in continuous quality improvement activities.
