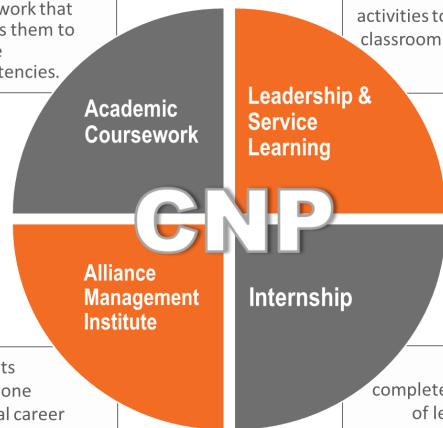


Certification Program

The **Nonprofit Leadership Alliance**, formerly *American Humanics*, at the University of Houston Graduate College of Social Work offers a specific undergraduate and/or post-baccalaureate curriculum which utilizes the competencies required nationally by the Nonprofit Leadership Alliance to prepare students for the credential of **Certified Nonprofit Professional (CNP)**.

Students participate in coursework that exposes them to 10 core competencies.



Students attend one national career development conference.

Certification requirements may be completed as a post-baccalaureate student.

2 Leadership & Service Learning

- ☐ Active participation in the **Nonprofit Leadership Student Association (NLSA)**.
Minimum of ten (10) hours per semester of association and/or committee meeting attendance.
- ☐ Organize and participate in at least **three (3) agency site visits**.
A minimum of three (3) offered EVERY semester
- ☐ Organize and attend **Fall Professional Workshop Series**.
Four (4) Fridays from 1:00—5:00 pm
- ☐ Organize and attend at least **one (1) Fall Retreat**.
One (1) full day in September
- ☐ Organize and attend at least **one (1) Flo McGee Career Development Institute (CDI)**
- ☐ Organize and attend at least **one (1) Annual Recognition Event**.
Typically late April or early May

Students are strongly encouraged to gain additional experience in the nonprofit sector through individual/ community volunteer work and leadership roles through NLSA.

Alliance Management Institute (AMI)

Students must attend at least one (1) national conference, Alliance Management Institute (AMI). AMI is an intensive educational symposium designed to expose the next generation of nonprofit leaders to the realistic experiences of a nonprofit organization.

Fund Campaign

- Occurs each fall semester preceding the conference in January
- Students raise funds for their conference and travel costs (typically \$950)

Internship

- Each supervised internship consists of **480 contact hours** in a 501 (c)(3) nonprofit organization.

To be completed part-time over two (2) semesters
or full-time over one (1) semester.

- This internship may be taken for internship for course credit.

Students must approve their internship credit hours with their departmental academic advisor **AND** the Nonprofit Leadership Alliance Program Director.
