PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

Learn Spanish in one of the most ancient and diverse cities in Spain . . . ¡Granada! Explore the narrow, cobblestoned streets of the former Muslim quarter, the Albaycin, wander the passageways of the Alhambra, or enter the white-washed caves of the Gypsies and experience the passion of a flamenco performance.

ACADEMIC OVERVIEW:

You will study at the Center for Modern Languages (CLM) of the prestigious University of Granada, founded in 1531. The CLM is located in the historic neighborhood known as “El Realejo”. Walking to class you will pass through winding cobblestone streets and hidden plazas. Spanish classes are taught in one of two historic buildings; one of which is a former palace dating from the 1600s. Class sizes are around 10 to 12 students.
