- 2) Complete **OISP's** online application at www.uh.edu/studyabroad/application/initial.php (take a printout to OISP of the online application for your first office visit)
- 3) Schedule an appointment with Maria Saldaña by email <u>mjsaldana@uh.edu</u> or by calling 713-743-9206. During your appointment, OISP will inform you of any other documents needed and deadlines.
- 4) Download the Course Equivalency Form from the OISP website. You must complete this form and take it to the Hispanic Studies Dept. (Agnes Arnold Hall Room 416) for advisor approval. Return the form to the OISP office after it is signed (501 E. Cullen Bldg., Room 501 F). If you are taking **CLASSES WITH LOCALS** in other subjects, the study abroad office can direct you to the appropriate advisor on campus.
