

Guiding Principles

Directions for teacher: Print principles and cut these into strips. Tape or tack each strip to various places around the room. Students will choose which of these best reflects their response to the scenarios. Have them "vote with their feet" by standing and walking to the principle they choose. Students will then discuss the reasons for their choice with the other students who chose that principle. Ask for volunteers to share with the group. (How many share is dependent on time.)
