### **UH Battle of the Bands to Decide Opening Act for Frontier Fiesta** *Presented by the Frontier Fiesta Association, the University Center & Associated Facilities and the Student Program Board*

The Frontier Fiesta Association, the University Center and Associated Facilities and the Student Program Board present Battle of the Bands, featuring comedian Blame as master of ceremonies. Battle of the Bands will be held on Monday, February 27, 2006 from 5:00 to 9:00 pm in the University Center Houston Room, doors open at 4:30 p.m. Four local bands, selected from 15 bands that entered to compete and consisting of at least one UH student, will perform 30 minute sets for a chance to perform as the opening act at Frontier Fiesta on Saturday, April 1, 2006. The winning band will also receive 8 hours of free recording studio time from Light In Sound Recording Studios. Comedian Blame, as seen on BET, will be master of ceremonies and will perform his stand-up comedy at the opening of Battle of the Bands, in-between band performances and after all bands have performed, while the judges scores are being tallied. A student board will judge each band based on their live performance to determine the winner. Free popcorn and refreshments will be provided while supplies last.
