Gerald D. Hines College of Architecture and Design

Admission to the College of Architecture is normally for study beginning in the fall semester. First, applicants are required to meet general University requirements in order to be considered by the College of Architecture. All applicants should submit applications, portfolios, and supplementary materials by the priority application deadline on **February 1**.
