

Special Program Requirements for Transfer Students

Gerald D. Hines College of Architecture and Design

Admission to the College of Architecture is normally for study beginning in the fall semester. First, applicants are required to meet general University requirements in order to be considered by the College of Architecture. All applicants should submit applications, portfolios, and supplementary materials by the priority application deadline on **February 1**. If submitted after this date, applicants will be considered on a space-available basis. Portfolio submission is highly recommended. Learn more at uh.edu/architecture.

Moore School of Music and School of Theatre and Dance: In addition to meeting all general admissions requirements, all music, theatre, or dance applicants must also submit a College of the Arts application and participate in an audition. Learn more at uh.edu/kgmca.

School of Art (Graphic Design, Painting, Photography/Digital Media, Sculpture, Art History and Art): In addition to meeting general admissions requirements, applicants must have successfully completed 6 hours of Arts coursework.
