Degree Plans

UC 11904 12F: Revisions to Medicine & Society Minor

When this minor was established in 2006 many students completed an internship to satisfy 3 of the required 18 SCHs. As the enrollment in the minor has increased it has become logistically problematic to maintain the internship program. The recommendation was to reduce the hours in the minor from 18 to 15 SCHs, and to modify the courses required in the minor to reflect current course offerings.

The Subcommittee recommends approval of this proposal.

UC 11905 12F: Changes to BS in Kinesiology Degree Plan

Replacing KIN 1252 Foundations of Kinesiological Studies and PEB 1101 Role of Exercise and Fitness on Health with KIN 1352 Foundations of Kinesiology, Health, and Fitness. Replacing HLT courses that are no longer taught with new KIN courses.

The Subcommittee recommends approval of this proposal.

UC 11937 12F: Modification of Digital Media BS Degree Plan

Replacing DIGM 3353 Visual Communications Technology with new course DIGM 2353 Page Layout and Design. Replacing DIGM 4378 Senior Project with DIGM 4399 Senior Honors Thesis.

The Subcommittee recommends approval of this proposal.

UC 11941 12F: Modification of Degree Plan - Human Resource Development BS

Updating degree plan to match course number and course title changes approved in related CBM003 forms.

The Subcommittee recommends approval of this proposal.

UC 11947 12F: Change of Language for Accelerated Bachelors and Master's Degree Program

Changing language on existing accelerated program to add "Global Retailing" graduate courses to the currently allowed "Training and Development" graduate courses.

The Subcommittee recommends approval of this proposal.

UC 11948 12F: Name Change for Minor in Consumer Science and Merchandising

Changing name of "Minor in Consumer Science and Merchandising" to "Minor in Retailing and Consumer Science." This name of the major in this area has already been changed; changing the minor name will make it match the major name.

The Subcommittee recommends approval of this proposal.

UC 11949 12F: CM Minor Pre-requisites for Architecture Students

Two architecture courses that have been allowed to satisfy prerequisite requirements for the Construction Management Minor are no longer taught. The content covered in those courses now resides in two new courses. The two new courses are being added to the list of prerequisites allowed for architecture students.

The Subcommittee recommends approval of this proposal.

UC 12251 13S: Changes to Minor in Kinesiology and Majors in Human Nutrition and Foods

Minor in Kinesiology: replacing DAN and PEB with KIN courses, including new KIN courses, reducing hours from 17 to 15.

Majors in Human Nutrition and Foods: currently there is a BA in Human Nutrition and Foods and a BS in Human Nutrition and Foods. The BA and BS degrees are being modified

to two BS options (ACEND Accredited Track and Nutritional Sciences Track). The current BA does not meet the six hours of foreign language required for BA degrees. The degree is being updated to meet the 12 hours of math/math reasoning required for BS degrees. Multiple course modifications.

The Subcommittee recommends approval of this proposal.

UC 12267 13S: Certificate in Global Studies and Research

Changing course "routes" to the Certificate, and modifying list of minors that can be used as foundation work for the Certificate.
