The Degree Programs and CB03-2 subcommittee met on April 9, 2014. The subcommittee recommends approval of the following catalog and degree program changes.

<u>UC12732</u>: Joint B.S. in Engineering/M.B.A. Program. This is a 4+1 program culminating in the B.S. in Industrial Engineering followed by the M.B.A. Degree requirements for both the B.S. and M.B.A. are modified to include designated courses from the other discipline. The program may be expanded in the future to include other Engineering departments.

<u>UC12748</u>: Biomedical Engineering Degree Changes. The number of hours for the degree is 131. Similar programs in the state require up to 134 hours.

<u>UC12749</u>: Civil & Environmental Engineering Changes. Adds catalog language describing the supporting material to be submitted with transfer credit petitions.

<u>UC12750</u>: Petroleum Engineering Program Changes. This makes a number of changes to course requirements for the major and minor in Petroleum Engineering. The net result is a reduction in the number of hours for the major from 127 to 126 hours.

<u>UC12782</u>: Update to ECE Program. The catalog changes are fairly extensive, but mostly amount to the replacement of the two degree options with the student's choice of one of six areas of concentration. The subcommittee agrees that the new program outline affords more flexibility.

<u>UC12671</u>: Changes to the Bachelor of Music in Applied Voice. Replaces a three hour Music elective with MUSI 3364: History of Music III. withdrawn furn agrida.

<u>UC12764</u>: Nonprofit Leadership elective Studies Program.

<u>UC12765</u>: Change to the Bachelor of Music in Applied Music: Replaces a three hour elective with MUSI 4370: Art Song Repertoire.

<u>UC12766</u>: Zero Credit Freshman Seminar in the Bachelor of Music. The subcommittee had questions about how one enforces a zero credit requirement, but approved the proposal because its goals are clearly worthwhile.

The proposal for a major in Women's, Gender and Sexuality Studies UC12761 is not recommended for approval at this time. The proposal refers to several new or changed courses

that have not been submitted for approval, namely, WGGS 2350, 2360, 3350, 3360, 3321, 3322, 4350 and 4360. Furthermore, the catalog description of program requirements is not clearly organized. The subcommittee feels that these aspects of the proposal should be addressed.
