#### III Administration Representatives Reports: Dr. DeFranco

Spring enrollment is currently down 1.3% (in comparison with this time last year).

With the implementation of PeopleSoft students it is currently planned that students be dropped for non-payment of tuition and fees the Friday before classes begin. Unlike in the current system, the seats will not be held for them, they will have to attempt to re-register for open classes.

#### IV PeopleSoft update: Sandy Frieden, Executive Director, Change Management

The project is on schedule for GoLive on March 1, 2007. With the first transactions being application/packaging of Financial Aid for 2007-2008.

In April they will begin registering for Summer 2007 on the old ADMIN system and in PeopleSoft for the Fall 2007 semester.

The second round of integration testing will begin February 5<sup>th</sup>.

Approximately 90 power users in the colleges and administrative units have been identified and trained. If you do not know your area's power user, contact S. Frieden.

Faculty who do no have administrative assignments will having training by demo and on-line tutorial. That will take place in November.

The student roll-out campaign is being planed. Contact S. Frieden if you wish to view the current draft. Students will be trained via on-line tutorial. There will be several stations across campus to help students during registration.
